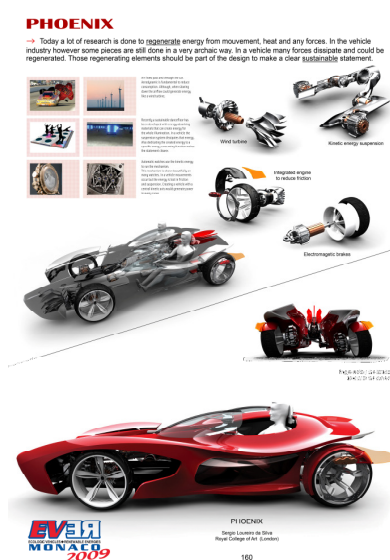

The Fifth International Conference and Exhibition on Ecological Vehicles and Renewable Energies (EVER'11) will be hosted by the principality of Monaco. Special Session Topics

The session encompasses the presentation of proposals for future ecological vehicles developed on professional and postgraduate levels. The aim is to select proposals that stimulate the renewing of vehicle design paradigms, relating aesthetic to technology and environment, using new sustainable materials to vehicles, proposing new models of use and ownership, all focusing on future scenarios of sustainability. The work will be presented in a Poster Session with optional display of physical model.

ASS3 - Boats and yachts

ASS4 - Ecological materials to vehicles

ASS5- Design of systems of use and ownership of vehicles

Submissions

Authors wishing to contribute to EVER'11 with posters are invited to submit two A4 pages of representative images and an abstract of one A4 page, including author name(s), mailing address, e-mail address and the preferred topic. The abstract should summarize the design proposal, providing its aim and conclusions. The conference language is English.
